Principal Report - Tuesday, October 3, 2023. - 6:30 pm

- 1. School Organization. Currently we have about 510 students housed in 23 classes. We have six portable classrooms. Currently, we are using 4 of them for our grade 5 and 6 students. This year we only have four Kindergarten classes and they are all located on the first floor.
- 2. Building Updates. The 2 single portables have been equipped with interactive projectors and speakers. This work was done over the summer break.
- 3. Health and Safety. We have started our fall safety drills last week. We completed the bomb threat evacuation on Friday. The drill went very well. On Monday we completed the first of three fire drills that we will do over the next week or so. On Wednesday Oct. 4th, we will practice a lockdown drill.
- 4. Communication to parents from Office: Emails and school messenger blasts, Website, Telephone calls home.
- 5. School Fundraisers: We will continue with: Dress down Fridays. \$2 per family 3x month. Pizza Days Every Friday.

Goal: Technology. We still need more iPads. Our iPad to student ratio is about 1:4.

- 6. We will be celebrating Halloween on Tuesday October 31st. Students will be permitted to wear their Halloween costume or Orange and Black attire on this day. Halloween themed activities are planned for the day. We are not running a fundraiser this year.
- Sports Update: Currently flag football has begun. We entered a senior girls' team as well as a senior and junior boys' team. Games started on the weekend. Cross-country event was held today. Once again, we were limited in numbers by the CYO. We sent grades 6-8 to the event.
